<p>As requested via CDA Dispatch I traveled to the above location and upon arrival on 112014 at 0115hrs I was met by Sgt. A. Johnson. Forensic Supervisor S. Yao and Forensic Specialists H. James and E. Williams also arrived on scene. A large number of TPD and FSU PD personnel along with Fire/EMS units were on scene also. A large area extending out from the FSU Strozier Library was taped off as a crime scene. I was advised that a male suspect had fired upon victims at the library and arriving Officers returned gunfire and the suspect was deceased.</p> <p>I was advised that one victim had received a gunshot wound outside of the library and others may have been fired at. I was advised that the suspect entered the library through the front south entrance near the west side and approached a service desk on the west end of the library lobby. The suspect was reported to have fired striking a second victim in the leg and attempted to fire on another victim but the weapon did not discharge.</p>

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The suspect was then reported to have walked to the east in the front lobby and at some point exited the library to encounter Officers who returned fire striking the suspect. Both victims shot by the suspect had been removed from the scene prior to my arrival and were being treated for their injuries. The suspect was still on scene. I along with Yao assisted by FSU Security entered the library and viewed video of the event. No exterior video was available.

The scene was photographed which included exposures with and without scales and numeric evidence markers. Areas and items photographed with a numeric evidence marker correspond to the listed item number on completed TPD property receipts. The Traffic Homicide Unit responded assisted by laser mapping the scene.

Spent ammunition casings of .40 caliber and .380 caliber were located on the ground and steps in front of the library. Projectile and metal fragments were also located.

The suspect who was lying on his chest with his head to the northeast and feet to the southwest was handcuffed behind his back. The suspect was on the elevated portion of the front exterior of the library. The suspect was clothed in jeans, shoes a sweater vest with a blue long sleeve shirt. A hat was lying near the suspect's head which appeared to have a hole/damaged area on the side. Personal effect items including a note, Texas drivers license, VISA card, Keys, a single round of .380 caliber ammunition and a cell phone. Were located on top of a brick planter to the right of the suspect. The VISA card and drivers license listed the name Myron May. Nine rounds of .380 caliber ammunition were located in the suspect's right front pants pocket. The suspect appeared to have gunshot injuries and damage to his clothing from gunfire.

Two rounds of .380 caliber ammunition were located on the ground. One was near the suspects left pants pockets and one near the right pants pocket.

At 0330hrs a SEM gunshot residue collection kit was collected from the suspects hands. The suspect's hands were bagged after the collection. A round of .380 caliber ammunition was located under the suspect's waist.

The suspect was placed into a disaster bag by Forensic personnel and removed from the scene and delivered to Strong and Jones Funeral Home who was standing by near the scene. The bag was sealed and photographed. The suspect was removed to the Morgue at 0450hrs.

An item/areas listed included in this report reflect on the items collected at the scene and consist of items #1-90 and #120-130.

Items #1-61 were located on the exterior of the library. The projectile #62, believed to be from the victim shot while under the service desk, was located in the library floor past the security turnstile. The victim was reported to have retreated through the turnstile and no projectile was recovered from his wound. Items #63-64 were swabs collected at the scene from the two cellular phones item #48 and 59. Item #66 was located outside.

Item #67, R-P .380 spent ammunition casing was located inside on the floor under the service desk on the west side. Items #68-75 projectiles and fragments were located inside the Starbucks at the east end of the lobby. Items/areas #77 - 80 were located outside. Areas #81-83 were located inside the

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Starbucks. Item #84 was an R-P .380 spent ammunition casing located outside. Number #84 was also used with a suspected gunshot strike to a sign stand inside the Starbucks. The strike was marked in error. Item #85 was a projectile recovered from the second floor window sealant above the Starbucks on the exterior.

Item #86 was located outside. Area #87 was located outside.

Two large double pane glass windows on the front south side of the library which is the Starbucks were broken. The pane to the exterior right was broken but mostly intact. The pane to the exterior left was partially intact except for an area near the center to the west, or left side. Seven strikes were located and marked on the right pane and labeled A-G. One strike was located on the left pane and marked H. Items #88-89 projectiles were located near the floor between the broken panes on the right side. Item #90, a projectile, was located under the right pane in the metal lower frame near the floor.

Items #88-89, projectiles were located and collected from the area near the floor.

The handgun located to the northwest of the suspect labeled as item #39 was a Lorcin model L380 .380 caliber serial number#454927. The safety was in the fire position. A magazine was lying beside the handgun. The magazine was loaded with four rounds of .380 caliber ammunition. A single round of .380 caliber ammunition was located loosed in the magazine well of the handgun.

No ammunition was located loaded in the chamber. The handgun was photographed and a swab was collected from each of the slide, trigger and grip areas. A swab was also collected from the magazine and the top or first visible round of ammunition in the magazine. A swab was also collected from the loose round of ammunition from the magazine well. It appeared that the hand gun may have received a gunfire strike on the right side of the slide near the ejection port.

Multiple searches on the interior and exterior were made for additional items of evidence which were not located.

The scene was cleared at 1115hrs on 112014.

On 112014 while at the TPD Forensic Unit I met with Officer Steve Wisecup of FSU PD and received items collected by his agency. These items were listed as TPD items #131-137.

On 112114 I attended the autopsy of Myron May (14M-462) which began at 0900hrs and was performed by Dr. Flannigan. Forensic Specialist H. James and E. Williams along with Investigators C. Papy and S. Cherry were in attendance. The sealed disaster bag was photographed prior to opening.

Photographs were taken of May clothed and unclothed. Photographs were taken of wounds. Photographs were also taken of the clothing as they were removed. Photographs were taken of property removed from May. Projectiles and metal fragments were removed from May and from the interior of the disaster bag. Scales were used in some of the exposures. A buccal swab and vial of blood were collected from May along with finger and palm impressions. The collected items were listed on a medical examiners receipt which was transferred to a TPD receipt. The items collected were listed on a TPD property receipt as #91-119.

On 112414 while at the TPD Forensic Unit Lab I processed the Lorcin .380 magazine and five rounds of .380 caliber ammunition collected as items #39. These items were exposed to Cyanoacrylate fuming,

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MBD and Bi-Chromatic powder. Latent prints were developed on the right slide area of the Lorcin handgun. These latent prints were later determined to not be of value.

On 120214 the green Glendale bicycle received from FSU PD was photographed at the TPD Forensic Unit Lab. A scale was used in some of the exposures. A suspected gunfire strike was documented on the bicycle frame below the handlebars.

All collected items will be forwarded to TPD Property and Evidence
